CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT to appropriate to the county of Dodge the sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the county of Dodge the sum of seven hundred and ninety-eight dollars and fifty cents, being the amount said county has paid the state for the support of insane persons not properly chargeable to said county. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT in relation to the circuit court of the county of Racine.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The circuit court of the county of Racine shall be deemed to be open for the transaction of business, from the commencement of one regular term to the commencement of another, and an adjournment of the term from day to day shall not be necessary to the validity of any proceedings therein. SECTION 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after Monday, the eleventh day of March, A. D. 1878.
