CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT relating to the opening of streets and alleys, and amendatory of the charter of the city of La Crosse.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eighteen of chapter V. of chapter one hundred and thirty-five of the laws of Wisconsin for one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to revise, consolidate and amend the charter of the city of La Crosse, approved February nineteen, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and the several acts amendatory thereof," is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following words: "Whenever it shall appear to the common council, by petition or otherwise, that injustice has been done to any property-owner in the assessment of such benefits or damages, the common council may remit such portion of the damages assessed in excess of benefits as they may deem just, and may compromise or settle with any person whose land is taken or assessed for the purpose of opening any street or alley, if they shall deem it for the interest of the city to make such settlement or compromise." **Amendment.**

SECTION 2. Section twenty-one of said chapter V., of chapter one hundred and thirty-five, of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, is hereby repealed. **Repealed.**

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
