CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a sum of money to Peter Swenson.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Peter Swenson, the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to authorize Joseph Harris to build and maintain a pier and dock in Sturgeon Bay.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Location and length of dock.

SECTION 1. Joseph Harris, his executors, heirs or assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a dock and pier, extending into Sturgeon Bay, on the western shore, from section seven (7), in township twenty-seven (27) north, of range twenty-six (26) east, in Door county, running in a northerly direction three hundred feet or more, to the usual steamboat channel, for the purpose of a steamboat dock and landing at the village of Bay View, on said Sturgeon Bay.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
