CHAPTER 133.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin Institution for the Education of the Deaf and Dumb, certain sums of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of ^{Appropriation,} any money in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, ^{\$30,000.} to the Wisconsin Institute for the Education of the Deaf and Dumb, the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), being in full for current expenses and miscellaneous purposes for the year 1879.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 134.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Boys, certain sums of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of ^{Appropriation,} any money in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, ^{\$52,000.} the sum of thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000), for current expenses at the Industrial School for Boys for the year 1879.

SECTION 2. For the erection of two (2) additional family buildings, and furnishing the same, the sum of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) is hereby appropriated.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
