

fined not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars, with costs of prosecution.

Justice of the peace to have jurisdiction.

SECTION 3. Any justice of the peace of said county of Polk shall have jurisdiction to hear, try and determine any complaints made for a violation of any of the provisions of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, A. D. 1881.

CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT to amend section one thousand three hundred and sixty-three of the revised statutes, entitled of drains and how maintained.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Supervisors may order additional bulkhead.

SECTION 1. Section one thousand three hundred and sixty-three, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: In case the supervisors in laying out a drain or ditch under the provisions of this chapter, or after such drain or ditch having been laid out, upon a subsequent application for a gate or bulkhead, and proceedings had on such application in the same manner as prescribed for laying out a drain, shall deem it for the benefit of the persons interested, that the lands drained or to be drained by such ditch, shall at a certain season of the year be overflowed, they may order a gate or bulkhead to be erected at one or more places in the drain or ditch, designating such places, and that such gate or bulkhead be kept closed during a certain season of each year, designating such season.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
