### CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-nine of the laws of the state of Wisconsin of 1878, entitled an act to revise the charter of the city of Chippewa Falls.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Hotels, boarding houses and restaurants excepted.

SECTION 1. Subdivision first, of section three, of subchapter five, of chapter one hundred and fifty-nine, of the laws of the state of Wisconsin of 1878, is hereby amended by adding to the said subdivision first, of section three, of subchapter five, the following: Provided, any ordinance, resolution or by-law, passed by the mayor and common council of said city of Chippewa Falls, relating to the hours of closing or opening of groceries, taverns, victualling houses, saloons or restaurants, shall not apply to any such places aforesaid which are attached to hotels, boarding houses, taverns or restaurants.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

### CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to authorize Eugene Shaw and D. P. Simons, and their assigns, to erect and maintain dams in and across Fisher creek, a tributary of Chippewa river, and to collect tolls on logs put in said creek and driven out of the same.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Location of dam.

SECTION 1. Eugene Shaw and D. P. Simons, of Eau Claire, Wisconsin, and their assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to maintain such dam or dams as they may have heretofore built in or across Fisher creek, a tributary of the Chippewa river, in
