CHAPTER 199.

AN ACT relating to the incorporation of the city of Oconomowoc, and amendatory of chapter two hundred and thirty-nine of the laws of 1879.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two of chapter ^{Elective officers} two hundred and thirty-nine, of the laws of 1879, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. The elective officers of the city shall be one mayor, one clerk, one assessor, one treasurer, two justices of the peace, one marshal, one street commissioner and one constable, who shall be elected at large in the city, and one supervisor and three aldermen from each ward, who shall be elected therein, one each year; and each of said officers shall be qualified voters in the city; but the mayor, supervisors and aldermen, shall also be householders or freeholders in the ward from which they shall be elected: provided, however, that no person shall be eligible to the office of treasurer of the city for two successive years. ^{Eligibility of treasurer.}

SECTION 2. All acts or part of acts which ^{Repealed.} contravene or conflict with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 200.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter two hundred and seventy of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1878, entitled an act to constitute a certain abstract of title to the real estate of the county of Outagamie a part of the official records of the office of the register of deeds of said county, and to provide for continuing said abstract and for the fees of said register.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
