CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the officers of the village of Brandon, in the county of Fond du Lac.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The acts and doings of all persons ^{Legalized.} who have acted as officers of the village of Brandon, in the county of Fond du Lac, since the attempted organization thereof, November 12, 1877, whether as president, trustees, clerk, treasurer, supervisor, marshal, constable, police justice, justice of the peace, pound master, fire warden, street commissioner, or health officer, are hereby legalized, and declared valid and binding in all courts, and places, the same as though said village had been fully and legally incorporated on said date, and said officers had acted under due authority of law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to repeal section two of chapter twenty-three of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to authorize road district number one, in the town of Winchester, in the county of Winnebago, to expend highway tax in the town of Clayton."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter twenty-three of ^{Repealed.} the general laws of 1863, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
