CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT relating to salaries of deputy sheriffs in Milwaukee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Salaries.

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 227 of the general laws of 1877 is hereby amended by striking out the words and figures fourteen hundred (\$1400) where they occur in the third line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the words fifteen hundred (\$1500), and by striking out the words and figures eight hundred (\$800), where they occur in the seventh line of said section, and inserting instead thereof the words and figures one thousand (\$1000), so that said section, when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 2. Said sheriff is hereby authorized to appoint one under sheriff, who shall receive a salary of fifteen hundred (\$1500) dollars per annum, to be paid monthly out of the treasury of Milwaukee county, and nine deputy sheriffs, of whom one shall act as clerk in the sheriff's office; the said deputy sheriffs shall receive a salary of one thousand (\$1000) dollars per annum, except the one acting as clerk in the sheriff's office, under the provisions of this act, who shall receive a salary of twelve hundred (\$1200) dollars per annum. The salaries of said nine deputy sheriffs shall be paid monthly out of the treasury of said Milwaukee county, and the salaries so paid to said under sheriff and said deputy sheriffs shall be in lieu of all fees, per diem and other emoluments of whatever kind or nature heretofore allowed by law.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts, in so far as they conflict with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
