

for the construction and maintenance of a bridge across the Kickapoo river, at the place designated in section 1 of this act, within ninety days after its passage and publication, then it shall be lawful for Wm. S. Waite, William Tate and Thomas Curley, and such persons as they may associate with them, to build a bridge across the said Kickapoo river, at the place designated in section one (1) of this act: provided, however, that in any case said bridge shall be a free bridge for public use.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to authorize the mayor and city clerk of the city of Milwaukee to sign, and the comptroller of said city to countersign, a certain city order in favor of A. B. Guilfuss treasurer of said city, and to provide for the payment thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to
sign order.

SECTION 1. The mayor and city clerk of the city of Milwaukee are hereby authorized to sign, and the comptroller of said city is hereby authorized to countersign, a certain city order, bearing date the 30th day of June, 1882, drawn by the city clerk of said city in favor of A. B. Guilfuss, treasurer of said city, for the sum of seven hundred and twenty-six dollars and fifty cents (\$726.50), pursuant to a resolution of the common council of said city, passed on the 26th day of June, 1882, for the purposes in said resolution mentioned.

SECTION 2. The payment of said sum upon the said city order, when signed and countersigned, as provided in the preceding section out of any moneys in the treasury of said city of Milwaukee, not otherwise appropriated is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication thereof.
