CHAPTER 450.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money therein named to the Milwaukee Industrial Exposition Association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Milwaukee Industrial Exposition Association, the sum of one thousand dollars for the year 1885, and one thousand dollars for the year 1886.

CHAPTER 451.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money therein named to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Girls.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Girls, five thousand dollars for the following purpose, to wit: For laundry, painting, repairs and gas fixtures.
