## JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 20.!

*Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring,* That the Judiciary Committee of the senate be and they are hereby instructed to draft and report to the senate, a bill to repeal certain laws which were erroneously enrolled and sent to the governor during the session of 1883, as follows: Chapter 272, laws of 1883 (No. 39, A.), to enlarge and extend the corporate limits of the city of Milwaukee. Chapter 261, laws of 1883, (No. 419, A.), relating to the service of process in justice court and amendatory of section 3608, chapter 155, revised statutes. Chapter 314, laws of 1883, (No. 400, A.), relating to the change of the place of trial of actions in certain cases and amendatory of chapter 119, revised statutes. Also to re-enact No. 421, A., laws of 1883, To authorize John E. Glover *et al.*, to improve the navigation of Willow River, etc., was not deposited with the secretary of state as a law.
