JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the superintendent of public property be, and he is hereby directed and required to distribute, of volume one, of the geological report of Wisconsin, now on hand, as follows: Five volumes to each member of the present legislature, chief clerks, and sergeants-at-arms, and elective state officers, in the capitol; one volume to each employe of the legislature, and newspaper reporters in regular attendance, and twenty volumes to the state historical society for exchange; one volume to each of the assistants and clerks regularly employed in the various offices in the capitol.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That one thousand copies of the report of the state librarian for 1883 and 1884 be printed, that eight hundred copies be bound in paper and two hundred copies be bound in cloth; said report to be distributed as follows: Six hundred copies to the legislators and four hundred copies to the state library.

JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the governor be, and is hereby authorized to allow the university college of law to occupy the west room, lately vacated by the state historical society, or any other room in the capitol, which will not incommode the state officers or legislative business, as a library and lecture room until such time as the same may be needed for state offices or legislative purposes.
