The mayor and alderman shall constitute the common council, and shall receive twenty-five dollars each annually in full compensation for their services as members of said common council, and the style of all ordinances shall be, "The common council of the city of Monroe do ordain," etc. The common council shall meet at such time and place as they by resolution shall direct. A majority of the aldermen shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to amend chapter 130, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Mayville."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Boundaries of city changed.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 2, of chapter 130, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: All that district of country in the county of Dodge, in the state of Wisconsin, known and described as follows, to-wit: The west half of the southwest quarter of section thirteen, and the southeast quarter of section fourteen, and the northeast quarter and the east half of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the north half of the southeast quarter of section twenty-three, and the north west quarter of the southwest quarter, and the west half of the northwest quarter of section twenty-four, and a piece of land commencing at a point on east bank of Rock river, thirty-eight and one-half rods south

of north line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section twenty-three; thence north along east bank of Rock river, thirty-eight and one-half rods to the north line of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter; thence east along north line twenty-two rods; thence south thirty-nine and one-half rods to a point nineteen and one-half rods east of beginning; thence west nineteen and one-half rods to the place of beginning, all in township twelve north, or range sixteen east, known as the town (of) Williamstown, in said county, shall be included in and constitute the limits of the city of Mayville; provided, that any cemetery grounds of any church society shall not be a part of the territory of said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to incorporate the city of Marinette.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER I.

CITY AND WARD BOUNDARIES.

SECTION 1. All that district of country in the county of Marinette and state of Wisconsin, hereinafter described, shall be a city by the name of Marinette, and the people now inhabiting and those who shall inhabit said district shall be a municipal corporation by the name of the city of Marinette, and shall have the general powers possessed by municipal corporations at common law; and in addition thereto shall have and possess the powers hereinafter specifically granted, and the authorities thereof shall have perpetual succes-
