CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to appropriate to George E. Tate the sum therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
to Geo. E. Tate,
contested seat.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Geo. E. Tate the sum of four hundred dollars, the amount of his costs, disbursements and expenses, necessarily incurred and paid in the matter of the contest of Isaac McCann, for the seat in the assembly occupied by the said George E. Tate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Forestville, in county of Door, and the town of Ahnapee, in the county of Kewaunee, or either of them, to build a bridge across the Ahnapee river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorizing
towns of For-
estville and
Ahnapee to
build bridge.

SECTION 1. The town of Forestville in the county of Door, and the town of Ahnapee, in the county of Kewaunee, or either of them, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a suitable bridge across the Ahnapee river, on the county line, between said counties of Door and Kewaunee, said bridge to be provided with a suitable draw, or be of sufficient height above the water to admit the passage of boats or vessels when necessary.
