CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a sum therein named to A. and Otto Oehler, of La Crosse county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to A. and Otto Oehler, jointly and as co-partners, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty dollars and twenty-five cents, to re-imburse them for peddler's license fees unlawfully required of them and paid into the state treasury. Appropriation to A. and Otto Oehler.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a sum of money therein named to Otto C. Techmer, of La Crosse county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Otto C. Techmer, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty dollars and twenty-five cents, to re-imburse him for peddler's license fees unlawfully required of him and paid into the state treasury. Appropriation to Otto C. Techmer.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
