CHAPTER 285.

AN ACT to amend chapter 345, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "an act to amend sections 1320, and 1321, of the revised statutes of 1878, relative to highways and bridges."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 345, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended by inserting in said section 1, after the words, "or any meandered stream runs," in the seventeenth line thereof, the following words; "and any city or incorporated village situated within five miles of the Wisconsin river," so that said section shall read when amended as follows: Section 1. Any county, town, city or village bordering upon, or through which any navigable or meandered stream runs, and any city or incorporated village situated within five miles of the Wisconsin river, is authorized to levy and collect a tax in the same manner that other taxes are levied and collected, not exceeding five mills, on the dollar, of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property thereof, for the purpose of building, or maintaining, or aiding in the building or maintaining a bridge across such stream, or to issue their corporate bonds for such purpose for an amount not exceeding two per centum on such valuation; and any two adjoining towns having a highway on the line between them, crossing such navigable or meandered stream are authorized to levy and collect a tax in the manner above provided, for the purpose of building or maintaining or aiding in the building or maintaining a bridge across such stream, or to issue their corporate bonds as above provided; but if a tax shall have been levied for such purpose in any such county, town or towns, city or village, their bonds for such purpose shall not be issued, for an amount exceeding the difference between such tax and two per centum of such assessed valuation.

CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT amending section 1, chapter 401, laws of Wisconsin of 1885, entitled, "an act relating to justices of the peace elected in the second and fourth wards of the city of Manitowoc."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Manitowoc.

SECTION 1. Chapter 401, laws of Wisconsin of 1885, is hereby amended, by adding after the word, "said," in the fifth line of said section the following: Second and fourth wards, and each of the justices of the peace elected in the first and third wards of the city of Manitowoc, is hereby authorized to hold and keep his office and place of business in either of said first and third wards, so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 1. Each of the justices of the peace elected in the second and fourth wards of the city of Manitowoc is hereby authorized to hold and keep his office and place of business in either of said second and fourth wards; and each of the justices of the peace elected in the first and third wards of the city of Manitowoc is hereby authorized to hold and keep his office and place of business in either of said first and third wards.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
