CHAPTER 414.

AN ACT in relation to the insuring of school property by district boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

School-district board may execute note for insurance premium.

SECTION 1. Any school-district board in this state, insuring in a town insurance company, the school property in its charge, is hereby authorized to execute a note for the premium.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 415.

AN ACT to provide for fishways at the outlet of Willow River in St. Croix county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fishways to be constructed at outlet of Willow River, St. Croix county.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of all persons owning, occupying or having charge of any dam now erected, or hereafter to be erected, on the outlet of Willow River in St. Croix county, Wisconsin, to construct in such dam, good, efficient fishways, under the supervision of the fish warden, or some person appointed by the fish commissioners of the state of Wisconsin, according to a plan furnished by said commissioners, and to keep such fishways in good repair, and open for the free passage of fish up and down, within four months from and after the passage and publication of this act.

SECTION 2. Any persons owning, occupying or having charge of any dam referred to in the foregoing section, who shall refuse or neglect to construct or keep in repair or keep open said fishways in accordance with section 1, of this act, after the space of four months from and after the passage and publication of this act, shall be liable to a fine of one hundred dollars and costs of suit; and for each and every six days he shall refuse or neglect to comply with the provisions of said section 1, he shall be liable to a fine of ten dollars and costs of suit.

Penalty for neglect.

SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent or conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.
