CHAPTER 482.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum therein named to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Girls.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Girls, to be expended by and under the direction of the board of managers, for necessary improvements of the buildings belonging to the state of Wisconsin and occupied by said school at North Point, in the city of Milwaukee, and for necessary repairs of said buildings during the ensuing two years, to-wit: The years 1887, and 1888.

SECTION 2. A correct account shall be kept of the expenditure of said sum and the same shall be reported to the governor and legislature in the annual report or reports of said school.
