## CHAPTER 278.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 201, of the laws of 1882, in relation to fences.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Amend section 1, chapter 201, by adding at the end of said section the following: Amending ch. 201, laws 1882, owner of swine liable for damages.  
 Provided, that this act shall not be construed to relieve the owner of swine from any damage they may commit upon enclosed premises of an adjoining owner.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT relating to the rate of interest on trust funds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The commissioners of public lands of the state of Wisconsin, are hereby authorized and empowered to loan the trust funds of the state, at a rate of interest not less than five per centum per annum; provided, all such loans shall be made in accordance with the provisions of chapter 17, of the revised statutes and the several acts amendatory thereof. Rate of interest on trust funds.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
