CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to change the boundaries of the towns
of Forest county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented
in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The north half of township thirty-five, of range twelve east, is hereby detached from the town of Pelican Lake and attached to the town of Crandon.

SECTION 2. The west half of township thirty-seven, of range thirteen east, is hereby detached from the town of Crandon, and attached to the town of Gagen.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect at the date of its publication.

CHAPTER 133.

AN ACT to fix the time of holding the circuit
court in the county of Green Lake.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented
in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court for the county of Green Lake shall be held as follows: On the third Monday in January and the second Monday in June in each year.
