CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT defining the name in which actions may be brought to collect the two *per centum* and forfeitures mentioned in section 1926, Revised Statutes, as amended.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Actions to collect the two *per centum* and forfeits mentioned in section 1926, Revised Statutes, as amended, may be brought in the name of the town, city or village in which the fire department therein mentioned is located.

Name in which action may be brought.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to require the publication of applications to village boards and city councils for private or corporate franchises.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of the Revised Statutes of the state of Wisconsin, relating to powers of village boards of incorporated villages, and as to powers of common councils of cities in the state of Wisconsin, in relation to granting franchises, are hereby limited and defined by the following provision: No franchise shall be granted by any village board of any
