CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to appropriate to George H. Kroncke
a sum of money therein named.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in
senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to George H. Kroncke the sum of five hundred and twenty-seven and forty one-hundredths dollars from the general fund, in full payment of the salary and mileage of said George H. Kroncke, as member of assembly from Kenosha county, in place of D. A. Mahoney, deceased.

CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT to amend section number 3627, of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes, entitled, "Offer of judgment by one defendant; proceedings against others."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in
senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3627, of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes of the state of Wisconsin, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "issue," and before the word "in," in the first line of said section, the words, "or on any day to which the case may be adjourned;" so that said section when amended, shall read as follows:
