CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT relating to weights and measures, and amendatory of section 1665, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, as amended by chapter 121, of the laws of 1881, and amendatory of section 1668, of the Revised Statutes of 1878.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1665, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, as amended by chapter 121, of the laws of 1881, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following to-wit: "And eight pounds for a bushel of plastering hair."

Amends sec. 1665, R. S., as amended.

SECTION 2. Section 1668, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following, to-wit: "A barrel of unslacked lime shall be ascertained by weight and shall be computed at two hundred pounds."

Standard for unslacked lime.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 56.

AN ACT to amend chapter 93, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "An act to amend section 436, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, relating to common schools."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 93, of the laws of 1885, amendatory of section 436, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, be and the same is hereby amended
