CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT to amend section 1496, of the Revised Statutes, relating to the duties of the commissioners of fisheries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1496, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "Said board shall be furnished a suitable office in the capitol, at Madison;" so that when so amended said section shall read as follows: Section 1493. The board may adopt by-laws for their government, not inconsistent with law, and shall meet at such times and places as they may prescribe. A majority shall be a quorum. They shall receive no compensation, but shall each be reimbursed his expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of his official duties, out of such appropriation as may be made by the legislature. They shall choose from their number a president, secretary and such other officers as their by-laws may prescribe; but no officer shall receive any compensation, except such as is herein provided for. Said board shall be furnished a suitable office in the capitol, at Madison.
