## CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT to provide for the sprinkling of streets in villages.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. All of the provisions of chapter 276, of the laws of 1887, are hereby made to apply to villages incorporated under the general statutes. All authority, powers and duties conferred upon town boards and town clerks, respectively, by said chapter 276, are hereby conferred upon the respective village boards and village clerks of such villages. Powers conferred on village boards.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 113.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of justices of the peace and constables, to fill vacancies in cities.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whenever a vacancy shall occur from any cause in the office of justice of the peace or constable, in any city incorporated under any special law, the common council shall fill such a vacancy by appointment, and Filling vacancies in office of justice of the peace.
