CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of additional court commissioners in Milwaukee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorizing appointment of additional court commissioners for Milwaukee county.

SECTION 1. The circuit court (and in vacation the circuit judge) of the second judicial circuit is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint as many court commissioners in and for the county of Milwaukee, as the proper transaction of business, in its opinion, may require.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 350.

AN ACT to amend chapter 197, laws of 1881, as amended by chapter 101, laws of 1882.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending ch. 101, laws of 1882. Return of attachment.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 101, laws of 1882, is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the following, to-wit: Provided, however, that the service, return and the time in which such return shall be made in such actions, shall be the same as required for the warrant of attachment in justice court, and in pur-

suance of sections 3702 and 3703, of the revised statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 351.

AN ACT to amend section 1, chapter 339, laws of 1889, entitled, "An act to provide for the relief of indigent and needy union soldiers and marines, and the indigent or needy wives, widows and minor children of indigent or deceased union soldiers, sailors or marines."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 339, laws of 1889, is hereby amended so that said section shall read as follows: Section 1. The county boards of supervisors of the several counties of this state are hereby authorized, and it shall be the duty of such boards to levy, in addition to the taxes now authorized to be levied by law, a tax of one-tenth of one mill upon the taxable property of their respective counties; and if said county boards of supervisors shall, in their judgment, deem said tax of one-tenth of one mill inadequate to raise a fund sufficient to carry out the intent of the provisions of this act, they may in their discretion levy, in addition to said one-tenth of one mill, such a per cent. or sum which together with one-tenth of one mill, will not be less than one-tenth and not more than three-fifths of one mill upon the taxable property of their respective counties; the tax determined upon by the board of supervisors to be levied
