CHAPTER 376.

AN ACT to authorize the Milwaukee gas light company to extend its mains.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Milwaukee gas light company is hereby authorized to supply gas and extend its pipes on the continuation of National Avenue, in the county of Milwaukee, to the west line of section thirty-five, provided the consent of the supervisors of the town of Wauwatosa be first obtained.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT to amend sections 3877 and 3931 of the revised statutes of Wisconsin relating to county courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3877, of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "day" where it occurs in the ninth line of said section, the words: "And on the attorney of all persons who have appeared in the proceedings herein in the same manner as no-

tices and papers are served in the circuit courts," so that when amended said section will read as follows: Section 3877. Every such order or notice of such hearing in the form and manner prescribed in section 4050, shall be published at least three successive weeks before the day fixed for a hearing, in a newspaper as provided in section 4045; and a copy thereof shall be served personally on all persons interested in the estate and residing in the county in which such application is made, at least twenty days before such day, and on the attorney of all persons who have appeared in the proceedings herein in the same manner as notices and papers are served in the circuit courts; but the notice may be dispensed with if all persons interested in the estate shall signify in writing their assent to such mortgage, lease or sale.

SECTION 2. Section 3931, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "five" where it occurs in the seventh line of said section the words: "And such notice shall be served upon the attorneys of all persons, who have appeared in the proceedings herein in the same manner as notices are now served in the circuit courts," so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 3931. Before the administration account of any executor or administrator shall be allowed, notice shall be given to all persons interested, of the time and place of examining and allowing the same. Such notice may be given personally to such persons as the court shall judge to be interested and by order direct to be notified; or by publication for three successive weeks before the day fixed for hearing in a newspaper as directed in section 4045. And such notice shall be served upon the attorneys of all persons who have appeared in the proceedings herein in the same manner as notices are now served in the circuit courts.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
