

normal school funds as they deem prudent, not to exceed the sum of sixty thousand dollars; such loan to be repaid from the income of the normal schools, and from any appropriations hereafter made for their support and maintenance as follows: to-wit: the sum of five thousand dollars, February 1st 1898, five thousand dollars February 1st 1899 and ten thousand dollars on the first day of February each year thereafter until said loan is fully paid and discharged.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT further defining the duties of county clerks, relating to furnishing the county clerks with forms for the assessment rolls, tax rolls etc.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Blanks to be furnished treasurers at county's expense.

SECTION 1. Section 1032 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, is hereby amended as follows: by inserting the words "and treasurers," after the word "clerks" as it occurs in the eighth line of such section, and striking out the word "and" as it occurs in the same line between the words "assessors" and "town," so that when amended the section shall read as follows: Section 1032. "The secretary of state shall prescribe and furnish to the several county clerks, forms for the assessment rolls, tax rolls, blanks and returns, required for the due execution of the provisions

of this chapter. Every county clerk shall, at the expense of the county, annually procure to be prepared according to such prescribed forms and furnish to each assessor in the county, in due season for use, an assessment roll, and to each town clerk a tax roll, and all other books, blanks and papers necessary to be used by such assessors, town and village clerks and treasurers, in the discharge of their duties under this chapter."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT authorizing Frank W. Epley to build and maintain a dam across Apple river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Frank W. Epley and his assigns are hereby authorized to construct, reconstruct and maintain a dam across Apple river, upon lands owned by him, on the southwest quarter of section twenty-six, township thirty-one north, of range nineteen west, of the fourth principal meridian in the county of St. Croix, said dam to be constructed for the purpose of the improvement of navigation, the manufacture of flour, feed and other milling products and the transmission of electric power; provided, that the said dam shall not raise the water to exceed thirty feet.

SECTION 2. The legislature reserves the right to amend, or repeal this act.
