CHAPTER 330.

AN ACT amendatory of chapter 121 of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1903, entitled "An act to amend chapter 286 of the laws of Wisconsin, for the year 1899, relating to the second municipal court of Bayfield county."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Substitution. SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 121 of the laws of Wisconsin for 1903 is hereby amended, by striking out the word "had" where the same first appears in said section 2 of said chapter, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "has."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT to provide compensation for the officiating chaplains of the senate and assembly for the session of 1903.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Compensation per week. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to each and every clergyman who has or may hereafter officiate as chaplain of the senate and assembly, the sum of fifteen dollars for each week of such service during the session of the legislature for the year 1903. The payments shall be made upon the certificates of the chief clerks of the senate and assembly showing the amount to which each such chaplain is entitled.
