CHAPTER 4.

AN ACT to amend chapter 438 of the laws of 1901, providing for employees of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Index clerk; compensation. SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 438 of the laws of 1901, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "day" in the twelfth line of said section at the top of page 626, the following, "*one index clerk, his compensation shall be four dollars a day.*"

Postmaster's assistant; compensation. SECTION 2. Section 4 of chapter 438, of the laws of 1901, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "day" in the ninth line of said section at the bottom of page 626, the following, "*one assistant postmaster, who shall be paid three dollars a day.*"

Provisions 5 and 6 to apply. SECTION 3. The provisions of sections 5 and 6 of chapter 438 of the laws of 1901, shall apply to sections 3 and 4 of said law as amended by this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
