**CHAPTER 82.**

AN ACT to create subsection 5 of section 2993 of the statutes, relating to postponement of execution sales.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** There is added to the statutes a new subsection to read: (Section 2993.) 5. If at the time appointed for any such sale the sheriff shall deem it for the interest of all persons concerned therein he may adjourn the same from time to time, not exceeding in all three months. In case of such adjournment notice thereof shall be given by public declaration at the time and place first fixed for the sale. If the adjournment shall be for more than one day further notice shall be given by posting or publishing the same, or both, as the time and circumstances may admit.

**CHAPTER 83.**

AN ACT to amend section 4 of chapter 72 of the laws of 1897, relating to jurisdiction of the municipal court for Racine county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Section 4 of chapter 72 of the laws of 1897 is amended to read: Section 4. Said municipal court shall have and exercise powers and jurisdiction in all civil actions *and special proceedings* within the county of Racine in law and in equity, concurrent with, and equal to the jurisdiction of the circuit court for Racine county, where the value of the property in controversy, or the amount of money claimed or sought to be recovered, after deducting all payments and set-offs, shall not exceed *twenty-five* thousand dollars, and also of all actions for the foreclosure of mortgages, and mechanic's liens, in which the amount claimed does not exceed the sum aforesaid, although the value of the property to be affected exceed that sum.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
