CHAPTER 496.

AN ACT to revise and amend section 1463 of the statutes, relating to state aid for agricultural fairs.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 2 and subsection 3 of section 1463 of the statutes are consolidated, revised, renumbered and amended to read: (Section 1463) 2. On or before the first day of February in each year, the president and secretary of each society, association or board, claiming such state aid, shall file with the secretary of state, upon blanks furnished by that officer, an itemized statement of all premiums actually paid in cash at the fair of the preceding season, which premiums must correspond with the published offers of premiums; also a statement that at such fair, all gambling devices whatsoever, and the sale of intoxicating liquors and exhibitions of an immoral character were prohibited and excluded from the fair grounds, and all adjacent grounds under their authority or control; and a full statement of receipts and disbursements for the past year. Such statement shall be verified by the oath of such secretary and be accompanied by a copy of the published premium list.

SECTION 2. Subsection 4 of section 1463 of the statutes is revised, renumbered and amended to read: Section 4438i. Any officer of any organized agricultural society, association or board in this state who, in pretended compliance with the provisions of section 1463 of the statutes, shall wilfully make and file any false or fraudulent list or statement shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each offense.

SECTION 3. Subsection 5 of section 1463 of the statutes is renumbered to be subsection 3 of the same section.

SECTION 4. This act takes effect when published.
