CHAPTER 500.

AN ACT to repeal subdivision (b) of section 4560a—1, relating to fishing in the Manitowoc river.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (b) of section 4560a—1 is repealed.

CHAPTER 501.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money herein named to the heirs of John Knoke, as a reimbursement for money paid to the state for certain lands to which the state had no title.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the heirs of John Knoke, deceased, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifty dollars and fifty cents as a reimbursement for moneys paid by the said John Knoke to the state of Wisconsin as the purchase price of land sold to him by the state, to which the state had no title.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 502.

AN ACT to create subsection 1a of section 1317m—5 of the statutes, authorizing county boards to construct or improve any road or street in any village or city in the county and providing the method of raising funds therefor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to section 1317m—5 of the statutes a new subsection to read: (Section 1317m—5) 1a. The county boards are given authority to construct or improve, or aid in constructing or improving any road or street in any village or
