CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to amend subsection 5 of section 172—54 of the statutes, relating to teachers' institutes and reading circles, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 5 of section 172—54 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 172—54). 5. There is annually appropriated on July first, nine thousand five hundred dollars, payable from any moneys in the normal fund income not otherwise appropriated, to the board of normal regents for institutes for the instruction of teachers as provided for in section 407 and for summer schools for teachers, *and for expenses connected with the conducting of a state teachers' and a state young people's reading circle organized by the Wisconsin Teachers' Association, provided, that not to exceed one-tenth of the sum appropriated in this section shall be allowed for such reading circle purposes in any one school year, and provided, further, that such expenditures for reading circle purposes shall, before being allowed, be approved by the state superintendent of public instruction.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
