CHAPTER 402

AN ACT to create a new subsection of section 20.40, and a new subsection of section 20.41 of the statutes, relating to Memorial Park, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new subsection of section 20.40, to read: (20.40) (6) On May 15, 1917, one hundred eighty dollars, and annually, beginning July 1, 1917, three hundred dollars, to meet the appropriation from the university fund income made by subsection (7) of section 20.41.

SECTION 2. There is added to the statutes a new subsection of section 20.41, to read: (20.41) (7) On May 15, 1917, one hundred eighty dollars, and annually, beginning July 1, 1917, three hundred dollars, for the upkeep of Memorial Park, to be expended under the direction of the Wisconsin Memorial Park commission.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 403

AN ACT to create section 454a of the statutes, and to amend section 20.23 of the statutes, relating to the granting of teachers' licenses, and to the powers of the state board of teachers' examiners, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 454a. 1. All persons who apply to the state board of examiners for a state license on the basis of work done in, or graduation from, an institution located outside the state of Wisconsin, shall pay a fee of one dollar for the examination of their papers, records, and credentials. All such persons, before receiving a state certificate, shall pay an additional fee of one dollar before a state certificate shall be issued.

2. The fee for the examination of the papers by the state board of examiners, and the fee for the issuance of a state certificate, shall be payable to the state superintendent of public instruction.

SECTION 2. Section 20.23 of the statutes is amended to read: 20.23 There is appropriated from the general fund to the state
