CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to amend subdivision (8) of section 926—11 of the statutes, empowering the issuance of bonds for the erection of public market buildings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (8) of section 926—11 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 926—11) (8) For the establishment of public baths and hospitals and the purchase of sites for the same; and for the erection, construction or purchase of buildings for city markets and for the purchase of land for * * * the same.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT to amend subsection 6 of section 1291 of the statutes, relating to the amount allowable for damages in laying out, widening or altering of highways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 6 of section 1291 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 1291) 6. Provided that when any such damages shall be awarded, pursuant to an order for the laying out, widening or altering of a highway, lying wholly within a town whose resident population shall be eight thousand persons, or over, or which shall lie wholly within a county having a population of three hundred thousand persons or over, according to the last state or United States census, that then and in such case, it shall not be necessary that such order or award be approved, or the highway accepted by said electors, but the same shall be valid without such approval or acceptance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
