CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section 27.01 of the statutes, relating to the powers of the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section 27.01 of the statutes is amended to read: (27.01) (1) (e) To allow the state agricultural and horticultural societies to establish and maintain, upon any portions of the lands of the state parks which it deems suitable, such nurseries, experiment stations, and buildings as will best serve the requirements of said societies, and to allow the use of portions of such parks, which it deems suitable, for buildings and playgrounds for school purposes, all of which shall be under the general supervision of said commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 195.

AN ACT to renumber section 3809 of the statutes to be subsection 1 of said section and to create subsection 2 of section 3809, relating to bonds of administrators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3809 of the statutes is renumbered to be subsection 1 of said section.

SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 3809 of the statutes to read: (Section 3809) 2. Provided that where it appears that no property will come into the hands of the administrator excepting the proceeds of any claims arising from decedent's death, or for injuries inflicted upon him before his death, then the administrator shall not be required in the first instance to give any bond; but shall give a proper bond to be fixed by the court before any such proceeds shall be paid over to him. And the person or corporation against whom such claims exist after the amount of them in each case has been ascertained, either by settlement or judgment, shall not be required to make payment to the administrator until the bond in each case, last above provided for, shall be given and approved by the court.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
