CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT to amend subsection (26) of section 70.11 of the statutes, relating to exemptions from taxation of homes for the feeble-minded.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (26) of section 70.11 of the statutes is amended to read: (70.11) (26) All real property, not exceeding * * * *three hundred and twenty acres*, and personal property of any religious corporation, society, institute or body, which is actually used and occupied for a home for feeble-minded, so long as said property is actually so used.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 56.

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 6.185 of the statutes, relating to the registration of electors in certain municipalities.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 6.185 of the statutes is amended to read: (6.185) (3) The clerk shall, as soon as convenient after this section takes effect, fill in the spaces provided in such cards, from the poll list kept at the last preceding general or municipal election, the last printed registration lists, together with the name of every person known by the clerk to be an elector of the municipality. As soon as the clerk shall have completed filling the blanks in such registration cards, he shall file the same in his office, and arrange the names of the voters in each precinct in alphabetical order *or by streets*. Such registration cards when so filed shall be the official registry for each precinct subject to be revised and corrected by the clerk as herein provided.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
