CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to amend subsection (4) of section 5.08, relating to publication of election notices.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (4) of section 5.08 is amended to read: (5.08) (4) Such clerk shall forthwith upon receipt thereof publish under the proper party designation, the title of each office, the names and addresses of all persons for whom nomination papers have been filed, giving the name and address of each, the date of the primary, the hours during which the polls will be opened, and state that the primary will be held at the regular polling places in each precinct. *The caption shall be set in twelve point bold face caps and the body of the notice in eight point type of which the party headings shall be in caps and the names of the several offices in bold face type as set forth in the model form printed in appendix to election laws. The columns shall not exceed two and one-sixth inches in width. The fee for such publication shall be paid for by the square as defined in section 6.82.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 242.

AN ACT to create section 331.045 of the statutes, relating to personal injury actions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to be numbered and to read: 331.045 Contributory negligence shall not bar a recovery in an action by any person or his legal representative to recover damages for negligence resulting in death or in injury to person or property, if such negligence was not as great as the negligence of the person against whom recovery is sought, but any damages allowed shall be diminished by the jury in the proportion to the amount of negligence attributable to the person recovering.
