If after such hearing the commissioner is satisfied that the corporation has failed to live up to all of its obligations under this chapter, he shall promptly revoke its license; otherwise he shall dismiss the complaint.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to amend subsection (5) of section 40.07 of the statutes, relating to the election of school boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (5) of section 40.07 of the statutes is amended to read: (40.07) (5) The school board shall act as inspectors of such election, and shall appoint two clerks who shall make and keep duplicate lists of the electors voting at such election. A plurality shall elect. *Provided that in counties having a population of five hundred thousand or more the board shall appoint five persons who shall act as inspectors, clerks and tellers of such election.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

AN ACT to create section 45.066 of the statutes, relating to cutting or trimming of trees placed as memorials on state trunk highways, and providing a penalty.
