CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to renumber 35.46 to be 35.46 (1) and to create 35.46 (2) of the statutes, relating to allowance for printers' wage changes in state printing contracts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 35.46 of the statutes is renumbered to be 35.46 (1).

SECTION 2. 35.46 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

35.46 (2) The director of purchases may include in the specification proposals for state printing a provision that the contract price shall be adjusted from time to time during the term of the contract as affected by an increase or decrease in the printers' wage scale. All such provisions in contracts approved by the director of purchases for the contract period commencing January 1, 1947 are hereby expressly ratified and confirmed.

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT to amend 58.07 (5) of the statutes, relating to humane societies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

58.07 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

58.07 (5) Any county, city, or village may appropriate for the maintenance and support of such societies in the prosecution within their respective boundaries of the work for which they are organized any sum of money deemed needful; but the aggregate of all such appropriations in any county shall not exceed \$1,200 in any one year; *except in counties having a population of 100,000 or more.* Each county may, in addition thereto, appropriate and pay to one authorized and active agent of any such society such salary as the county board may fix.
