## CHAPTER 333.

AN ACT to create 20.206 of the statutes, relating to the acquisition of Wildeat Mountain for purposes of a state park and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.206 of the statutes is created to read:

20.206 Whereat Mountain State Park. On July 1, 1947, there is appropriated from the general fund to the state conservation commission, \$75,000, to be used to acquire lands and develop a state park to be known as Wildeat Mountain state park in the town of Whitestown, Vernon county in accordance with the report of the state planning board prepared pursuant to joint resolution No. 99, A. of the 1945 legislature.

## CHAPTER 334.

AN ACT to amend 194.47 (3) of the statutes, relating to exemption from tax on motor carriers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

194.47 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

194.47 (8) Operations of motor vehicles used for the transportation of passengers which take place entirely within contiguous incorporated cities or villages and in municipalities contiguous to that in which the motor carrier has its principal place of business, or entirely within one municipality or municipalities contiguous thereto.
