CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT to renumber 40.47 (6) to be 40.47 (6) (a) and to create 40.47 (6) (b) of the statutes, relating to the payment of the high school tuition tax apportionments from surplus municipal funds on hand.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 40.47 (6) of the statutes is renumbered to be 40.47 (6) (a).

Section 2. 40.47 (6) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

40.47 (6) (b) In lieu of placing the amount due for high school tuition upon the tax roll as provided in paragraph (a), the governing body of any municipality required to pay such tuition may by resolution authorize its treasurer to pay the amount of such tuition as certified by the county clerk out of surplus municipal funds, provided no portion of such municipality forms a part of a high school district.
