CHAPTER 515.

AN ACT to amend 66.11 (1) of the statutes, relating to qualifications of a chief of police.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.11 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.11 (1) No person shall be appointed deputy sheriff or police officer of any county or city unless he is a citizen of the United States and shall have resided in this state continuously for one year immediately preceding. This section shall not affect common carriers, nor apply to a deputy sheriff not required to take an oath of office *nor to a chief of police.*
