CHAPTER 101.

AN ACT to amend 85.67 (6) of the statutes, relating to cables or chains as additional couplings for cabin trailers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.67 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.67 (6) Whenever a cabin trailer is used in connection with a motor vehicle upon the highway it shall be attached *by a coupling so * * * that the trailer will follow in a direct line with the propelling vehicle, without sideswing or wobble and in addition shall be coupled with stay chains or cables to the vehicle by which it is drawn which chains or cables shall be of sufficient size and strength to prevent parting from the drawing vehicle should the regular coupling break or become otherwise disengaged.* The * * * couplings shall conform to the regulations of the motor vehicle department.
