CHAPTER 690.

AN ACT to amend 66.906 (4) (a) of the statutes, relating to municipal retirement annuities upon reentry into municipal service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.906 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.906 (4) (a) Notwithstanding the fact that any annuity is payable for life, if any annuitant receiving a retirement annuity enters the service of any municipality, the annuity payable to such annuitant at that time shall be terminated as of the end of the month prior to the date upon which such person entered such service, except that no annuity shall be terminated when the total earnings of the annuitant in all such service shall not exceed * * * \$1,000 in any calendar year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1951.
