CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to create 23.09 (8a) of the statutes, relating to the powers of the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

23.09 (8a) of the statutes is created to read:

23.09 (8a) The commission may on its own motion and shall, when so directed by the governor, assist other state, county, and local governmental agencies or do all things reasonably necessary in the rescue of persons lost in the forests of the state, or who may be otherwise in danger of loss of life, in the recovery of the bodies of drowned persons, and in cases of emergency or disaster, by assigning equipment and employes of the commission to such rescue, recovery, emergency, and disaster relief missions.
