CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend 41.01 (2a) of the statutes, relating to pre-school classes for visually handicapped children.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.01 (2a) of the statutes is amended to read:

41.01 (2a) Any school district which operates a class for the deaf and hard-of-hearing or visually handicapped or Wisconsin school for the deaf or Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped may provide instruction for pre-school deaf or visually handicapped children and their parents. The plan for conducting these classes shall comply with requirements set up by the state superintendent.
