CHAPTER 381

AN ACT to authorize the Chippewa Rod and Gun Club of Chippewa Falls to build and maintain a bridge and abutments thereto so as to provide a public roadway therein described, across a portion of the Holcombe dam flowage from the mainland to an island located in said flowage and leased by the Chippewa Rod and Gun Club.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The Chippewa Rod and Gun Club of Chippewa Falls is hereby authorized to build and maintain a bridge with necessary abutments to provide a roadway across a portion of the Holcombe dam flowage from the mainland to an island leased by it and located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 2, township 32 north, range 6 west in Chippewa county. The center line of the roadway to be as follows: The center line of the old town road running north and south in the SE portion of said quarter section extended north from the north end of said old road from the mainland to said island, which center line is intended to be and is the center line of that portion of said old town road now inundated; provided that the road shall be constructed so as to comply with town road specifications as to safety and be open to the public; that there be provided in the roadway a bridge with a clear span or spans of adequate width and height so as to allow a sufficient flow of water to prevent stagnation and so as not to impair the rights of the public for the purposes of navigation and fishing. Within 90 days after the effective date of this act the public service commission shall, after due notice, hold a hearing for the purpose of taking evidence to determine whether the construction complies with section 31.23 (3) (a) and (c) of the statutes. The entire construction herein authorized shall be deemed a bridge within the meaning of and be subject to section 31.23 (d) of the statutes.
